PROCEDURE

- A Model:** put first jumbled word/phrase and unjumble as a class.
- B Unjumble:** Ss re-order the letters to make words/phrases.
- C Board:** ask individual Ss to write answers on board.
- D Erase:** all but first letters and elicit words/phrases again.
- E Drill:** individually and chorally.
